- Optimize and adapt existing data management systems to meet project and donor requirements
- Compile, clean, analyze and consolidate project data; contribute to reporting and analysis
- Coordinate with MEAL focal points and project teams to ensure data quality and timely collection



- Deliver MEAL training and support the implementation of data quality control measures for stakeholders (identification of needs, design of training plans, implementation of training programs and data quality control guide).
- Provide technical advice to project teams and contribute to the documentation of lessons learned and project results

Education

 Bachelor's degree in a relevant field (statistics, international development, economics, social sciences), or equivalent combination of education and professional experience

Experience

- Minimum 5 years of experience in the design and implementation of MEAL systems within development projects led by national or international NGOs
- Experience in designing tools and strategies for data collection, analysis and reporting
- Proven skills in using digital data collection platforms (e.g., KoboToolbox, ODK) and database management
- Proficiency in Excel and experience with statistical analysis software
- Experience in delivering training sessions and facilitating capacity building

Other requirements

- Fluency in written and spoken Vietnamese and English
- Ability to think systematically, work collaboratively and propose innovative solutions
- Strong organizational skills, reliability, and ability to manage multiple priorities under tight deadlines
